#### **POWER CUTS**


Due to the poor wet season last year and because the source of electricity is hydroelectric power, everyone in Zambia is suffering 8+ hours of power cuts every day. The wet season runs from **December to April.** 

#### **WINTER AT MUTENDE**

All the children have had a new warm blanket. Years of wear and washing meant that the old ones were no longer warm enough for the winter months of June and July.



### **CHRISTMAS AT MUTENDE**



Last Christmas there were ten children who did not have any extended family to go home to, so they spent Christmas at Mutende with their House Mothers and Joshua. They had a chicken for Christmas dinner and attended the church service.

# **GROWING UP, MOVING ON**

When the children become 18 they move into one of the 2 separate youth houses, based in the community of Lullamba. They live here until they have finished their education and have learnt to live more independently. In the Boys Youth house are five boys and their House Leader – John. Both Youth Houses have large gardens which the young people use to grow vegetables. They also have Avocado and Mango trees.



In the Girls Youth House are three girls and their House Leader - Mercy. Some of the young people in the youth houses are completing their education to Grade 12 – the equivalent of A levels in the UK. They then go on to further education or skills training. Another three girls live here during college holidays. There are another four Mutende young people, living outside the facility whose education is supported by Mutende.



### A BUS FOR THE CHILDREN

In August Mutende Children's Village got the bus they have been hoping for. This is thanks to a very generous donation from a Bristol sponsor and to the Bishop for driving it from the docks in Dar Es Salaam in Tanzania. Mutende will run the bus from the profit made from rearing chickens.



Thanks to Swansea University and local help, Mutende has a new, purpose built, chicken house.





# THE CLASS OF 2019

The school now educates 179 children including 29 Mutende children alongside children from the local community in Lullamba. Look for Jeremiah in the 5th picture. He is helping the Grade 3's with their reading
